Last April 21st to 22nd, 2017, SHFC held its annual team building activities in Canyon Cove located at Far East Road, Piloto Wawa, Nasugbu, Batangas, a two (2) and half hour trip from Metro Manila. It was participated by one hundred eighty (180) officers and employees.

The theme for this year's team building is "*SHFC- A Pirates Adventures.*" In the morning, various activities were prepared to test each group's synergy, cohesiveness and camaraderie by giving out materials to each team to innovate among themselves in making a flag that would symbolized their team based on "A Pirates Adventure" theme. On the late morning, the game starts in making pirates flag contest. However, the groups were able to show qualities of leadership and created a more positive and cohesive team environment despite the fact that they belong to different departments of the corporation.
