Mr. Jovito Camposano Labajo has spent 34 years of community work in social change/transformation movement and community development. He started as a community volunteer worker of the Kapatirang Pilipino, Inc. (KAPIL) in the depressed areas of Metro Manila and Dasmarinas, Cavite during the dark days of Martial Law. He got involved with the underground movement that resisted the Martial Rule by then President Ferdinand Marcos after the 1978 Interim Batasang Pambansa (IBP) election. He was incarcerated for five and a half years (5 1/2 years) for alleged violation of the repealed Republic Act 1700 (Anti-Subversion Law). After his release from Camp Bagong Diwa, Detention Center in Bicutan, Taguig City last February 27, 1986, he became Assistant Civil Security Officer and Assistant Community Relations Officer of the local government of Quezon City from 1986 to 1992. It was also a period of active involvement in the organization of Pilipino Democratic Party-Lakas ng Bayan (PDP-LABAN) in Quezon City and participation in campaign management in the past electoral exercises during that period until May 2010.

Likewise, he has initiated the incorporation of the Philippine Foundation for Integrated Alternative Development Inc. (PFIAD, Inc.) in 1988 and the Center for Community Awareness and Development, Inc. (CCAD, Inc.) in 1992 that provided orientation, organization and mobilization of urban poor communities towards community development.

Furthermore, he has completed trainings on environmental concerns such as Pollution Control, Bamboo and Cacao production and Disaster Preparedness and Mitigation.

He has acquired training on Community Mortgage Program which was facilitated by the Presidential Management Staff (PMS) in 1988. He was involved in some social preparation activities in urban poor communities that led to the implementation of development programs for the informal settlers in the area.

He has been actively involved in the last May 10, 2010 election through the Mabuting Pilipino Movement and Campaign for Social Change. Currently, he is the Vice Chairperson of the Kapulungan ng mga Sandigan ng Pilipinas (**KASAPI**) and co-convenor of the Kilusan para sa Pagkakaisa, Pagkakasundo at Pag-unlad (**KILOS PA**) that are advocacy and social movements that aim to mobilize basic and marginalized sectors of the Philippine Society towards social reform and development.
